Daupler Notify is now live! This free alert system keeps you informed about water and sewer service interruptions, repair progress, and estimated restoration times. You choose how and when to be contacted, by cell or landline. You don't need a utilities account to sign up, but it is better to register by calling the Water Department to register at (575) 894-7331. This way you can link your account directly to your notification settings. You can also scan the QR code to the right. Stay informed and in the know!

PUBLIC NOTICE

ADDRESS UPDATES COMING TO TRUTH OR CONSEQUENCES FOR 911 GIS COMPLIANCE

The City of Truth or Consequences, in collaboration with Sierra County, is in the process of finalizing address errors within city limits to comply with the State of New Mexico's 911 Geographic Information System (GIS) standards.

This update will enhance the accuracy and efficiency of emergency response services including police, fire, and medical personnel. It will also support better coordination with postal delivery, utility services, and official records.

Some property owners will be affected by this change. If your address is impacted, you will receive an official letter notifying you of the following: (Letters will be mailed after 10-1-2025)

- Your current address and the new assigned address.
- A transition period, typically 60 to 90 days, during which both addresses will remain valid.
- The date your old address will become invalid in official and emergency systems.

The city will make every effort to assist residents and businesses with this transition and to ensure updates are clearly communicated and documented.
